Sixth Step: Complete Evaluation Forms

The **post-test** follows directly after the evaluation is completed. Your score is available immediately, and the learner must get it right before advancing to the next question. There is no limit to the number of times the question can be completed (at least for now) so you can change any incorrect answer. You are given the opportunity to take the test more than once should you wish to change an incorrect answer. All evaluations and post-test must be completed within **7 days**, and the credits will appear on the CPE Monitor within **30 days**.
