



## CALL FOR VOLUNTEERS

Dear New Hampshire Pharmacist,

The New Hampshire Metropolitan Medical Response System (MMRS) in collaboration with the New Hampshire National Guard is seeking New Hampshire registered pharmacists to support COVID-19 vaccination efforts across the state. Currently the New Hampshire National Guard operates thirteen fixed vaccination sites utilizing a drive-through vaccination clinic delivery model. This Point of Distribution (POD) model will be used throughout all phases of the COVID-19 vaccine distribution to the residents of New Hampshire and other eligible vaccine recipients as determined by the Department of Health and Human Services.

The Metropolitan Medical Response System (MMRS) – Medical Task Force 1 is a self-contained unit of volunteer doctors, nurses, pharmacists, paramedics, EMTs, mental health professionals and non-medical personnel who are available to respond statewide with the primary mission of medical support to first responders at Weapons of Mass Destruction incidents. Other missions include medical support at hazardous materials incidents, mass casualty incidents, public health events and assisting hospitals during a surge event. The task force is an ESF-8 (Emergency Support Function) resource under the direction of the New Hampshire Dept of Health and Human Services, Emergency Services Unit.

Interested pharmacists may volunteer to participate in statewide vaccination efforts must have completed the APhA Pharmacy Based Immunization Delivery Program, hold an unrestricted license to practice pharmacy in the State of New Hampshire with an Immunization Endorsement from the Board of Pharmacy, and hold a current CPR/BLS Certification from either the American Heart Association or American Red Cross.
